Washing and shampooing of both carpets has also now been completed. Thanks to our Caretakers for their persistence in achieving this outcome.




Caretaker Meeting Minutes

Booking Events at Palm Lake


Resident's Committee request that persons booking extra activities/presentations please be mindful of clashes with listed activities as this impacts on both events.
