

At the July Management Committee Meeting there was a General discussion regarding access for emergency vehicles and community service personnel Section 87 & 87A of the Act. The main problem appears to be that the Communications Centre for emergency services sends the first available emergency vehicle, which may not be a local one, so may not have the current code for access into PLR Bargara. Local vehicles and the Local Communications Centre has the codes, but if out-of- town vehicles are sent, they may not have the gate code.

There followed some discussion regarding the possibility of leaving Gate 1 unlocked between 6.00am and 6.00pm daily to eliminate the problem during daylight hours. Survey below.
