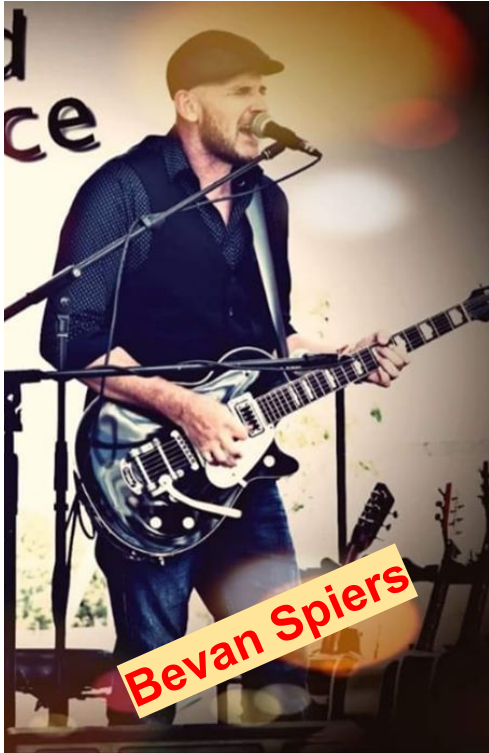

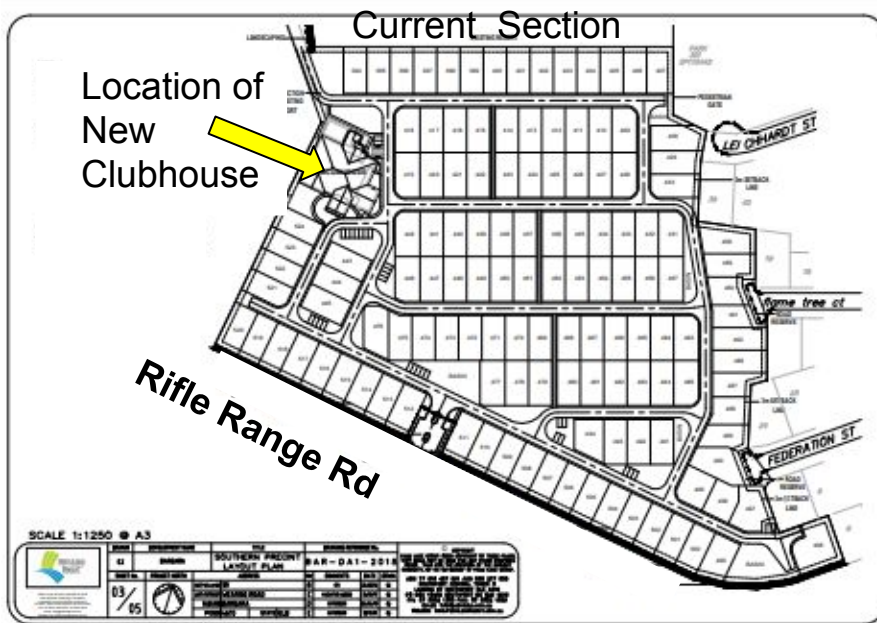
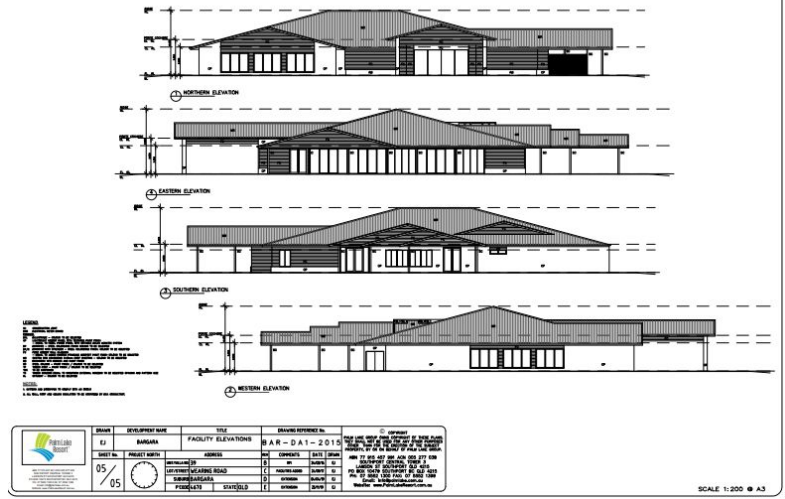
A huge Thank You to all involved in organising the games, preparing and cooking the delicious food. Also thanks to Sue from the sales office for presenting the winners of prize money their loot.

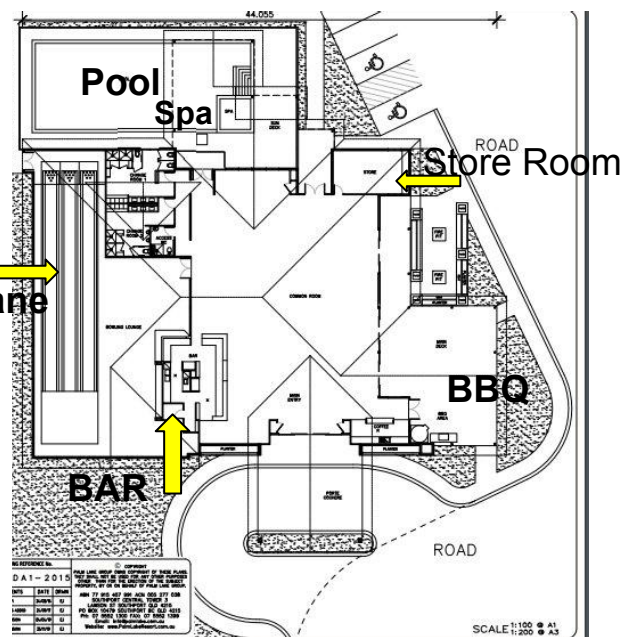
